
INTENDED ACTION: Amend the rule

CHAPTER 142-1-1

ORGANIZATION OF THE ALABAMA ATHLETE AGENTS REGULATORY COMMISSION

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142-1-1-.01 Organization

(1) The Alabama Athlete Agents Regulatory Commission is continued in existence as the Alabama Athlete Agents Commission (hereinafter "the Commission") and is established by Section 8-26AB-30, Code of Ala. 1975, and The Commission performs duties set forth in Title 8, Chapter 26AB, Code of Ala. 1975. Section 8-26AB-30, Code of Ala. 1975, also provides that the Secretary of State provides administrative support for the Alabama Athlete Agents Regulatory Commission, and Section 8-26AB-30(i), Code of Ala. 1975, authorizes the Secretary of State to administer Title 8, Chapter 26AB, Code of Ala. 1975.

(2) Requests for information pertaining to the Revised Alabama Uniform Athlete Agents Act and the Alabama Athlete Regulatory Commission may be submitted through the Office of the Secretary of State via several methods:

(3) Organization. The organization of the Alabama Athlete Agents Regulatory Commission is set forth in Section 8-26AB-30, Code of Ala. 1975.

(4) Bad Checks. (1) If the Secretary of State's Office, in performing administrative duties for the Commission, receives a check or negotiable instrument that is dishonored by the institution upon which it is drawn (hereinafter "bad check"), the Secretary of State's Office may charge a bad check fee as provided for in Code of Alabama 1975, section 8-8-15. The fee to be charged shall be the maximum allowed by law.

(2) If the Secretary of State's Office receives a bad check, the Office shall provide notice to the person making, drawing, uttering, or delivering the instrument in accordance with Code of Alabama 1975, section 13A-9-13.2.

(3) If the bad check was tendered for the purposes of registering with the Commission or renewing registration with

the Commission, payment of the full amount of such check or instrument plus a service charge, if imposed by the Secretary of State, must be paid in full prior to the registration or renewal of registration by the person seeking registration or renewal of registration.
