The County Commission is authorized to provide for its property and affairs; and for the public welfare, health, and safety of its citizens through unincorporated areas for the purpose of the protection of the county and public property under its control, except as otherwise prohibited and/or defined by law. The authorized powers include: (1) Abatement of weeds as a public nuisance; (2) Control of litter or animal nuisances; (3) Control of fire or rubbish; (4) Control of landmarks which create a public nuisance because of an accumulation of items; and (5) Abatement of noise, unsanitary sewage, or pollution creating a public nuisance.
